

London Youth Games - Girls Cricket Finals report

After 3 wins out of 3 at the Qualifying competition in Harrow, Team Richmond travelled to Lord's on Sunday 28 February 2016 to compete in the Cricket Finals.

The team, who all play for Bushy Park Girls CC and attend Collis Primary, Waldegrave, Teddington and Surbiton High respectively, were supported by a big crowd of families, friends and coaches.

Richmond's first match was a quarter-final clash against Harrow. After winning the toss, Richmond chose to field and managed to bowl Harrow out for 101. A great batting display saw Richmond ease to the total, reaching 104/2 in just 7 overs.

A tough Semi-Final clash against Bexley was to follow, with Team Richmond only managing a total of 58 runs before they were bowled out. However, some expert bowling and fantastic catches in the field would see Richmond progress to the Final for the first time ever, bowling Bexley out for 42.

Hammersmith and Fulham would be the other finalists and after some magnificent fielding and bowling, Richmond restricted their opponents to 73 runs. But, it wasn't to be for the Richmond Girls and they would take home the Silver medals. A magnificent effort from everyone involved and a great boost to the overall Jubilee Trophy standings.

The combined scores of the squad leave Richmond in third position in the Jubilee Trophy standings.
