Tranche 3 – East Twickenham, St Margarets, Richmond

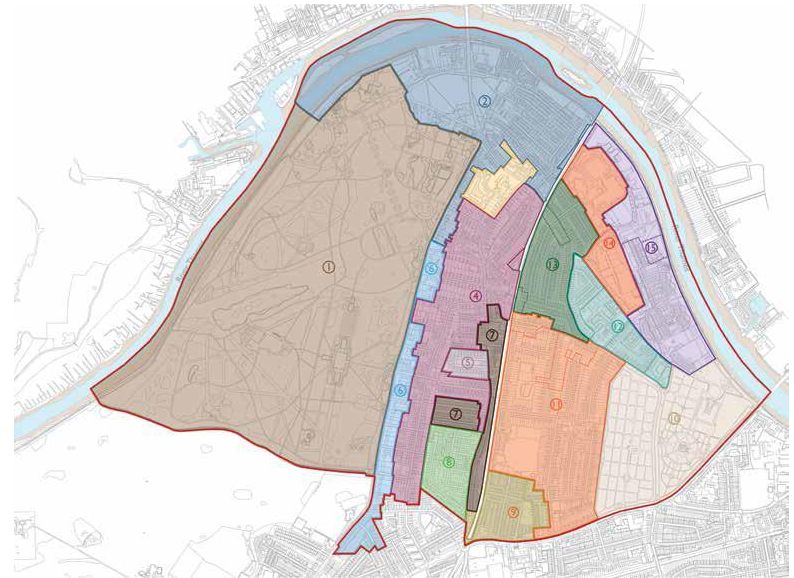
Tranche 4 – Hampton, Hampton Wick, Hampton Hill, Teddington

Mortlake, East Sheen, Barnes

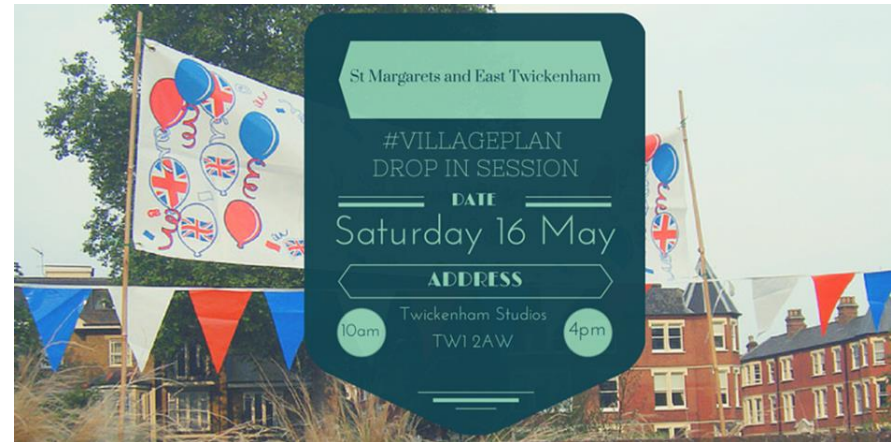
- Supplementary Planning Documents to be published very shortly.
