- You and your spouse or partner are receiving one of the following benefits: Income Support; **or** Jobseeker's Allowance (Income-based); **or** Employment and Support Allowance (Income related); **or** Child Tax Credit, **but not also receiving Working Tax Credit** and has an annual taxable income, as assessed by the Inland Revenue, of less than £16,190 from 6 April 2011 **or** Pension Tax Credit and has an annual taxable income, as assessed by the Inland Revenue, of less than £16,190 from 6 April 2011 **or** the 'Guaranteed' element of State Pension Credit; **or** financial support in accordance with the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999, from the National Asylum Support Service (NASS) or the Council's Asylum and Resettlement Team.
