You must complete a parkrun between 31 December 2016 and 25 February 2017 to be considered for the team.

The race is a championship event for young wheelchair athletes and open to young people all over the UK in age category races: under 14 & under 17.

Boys and Girls - U-14: 01/09/2002 - 23/04/2006

Boys and Girls - U-17: 01/09/1999 - 31/08/2002

Must be aged over 11 and under 18 on 23 April 2017.

The entry criteria requires participants must be able to self propel themselves over three miles within the time limit of 45 minutes. Competitors must wear a helmet & gloves and can either use a standard or racing chair.
