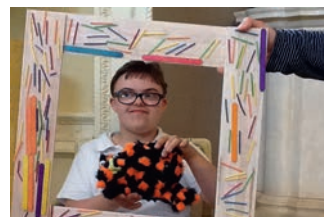

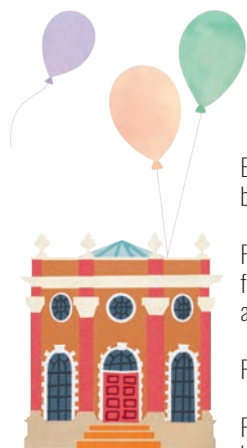
CHILDREN'S ART PARTIES
