1. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works which will be carried out as part of the Twickenham Town Centre Improvement Scheme they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce no waiting and loading at any time restrictions.
1. whilst the road works take place in York Street from its junction with Kings Street to the junction of Richmond Road and Sion Road no person may permit any vehicle to;
 - a. waiting in that section of the road where appropriate signs and cones are put on site; or
 - b. load in that section of the road where appropriate signs and cones are put on site; and
2. The order will come into effect on 28 June 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner.
3. The Council is giving notice separately of its proposals to make permanent orders in connection with the Twickenham Town Centre Improvement Scheme, two of which will contain measures similar to those provided for by the order referred to above. .

Temporary REMOVAL OF PARKING BAYS**

2. The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate works in York Street which will be carried out as part of the Twickenham Town Centre Improvement Scheme they intend to make a temporary Order, the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit and will remove 4 parking bays as specified in paragraphs 2 and 3 below.
3. The order will come into effect on 10 June 2013. The order will remain in force for a period of 18 months or until the works are complete, whichever is the sooner.
4. The Council is giving notice separately of its proposals to make permanent orders in connection with the Twickenham Town Centre Improvement Scheme, two of which will contain measures similar to those provided for by the order referred to above.
