Temporary waiting restrictions Dean Road, Hampton

- The Council of the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames HEREBY GIVES NOTICE that to facilitate the safe and unobstructed delivery of temporary classrooms to Hampton Academy they are introducing temporary waiting restrictions in Dean Road, Hampton.
- 2. Whilst the works take place no person may permit a vehicle to wait on the north-west and south-east sides of Dean Road, Hampton, from its junction with Hanworth Road, Hampton to its junction with Bishops Grove, Hampton

between the hours of 6am and 6pm on Friday 26 October and Saturday 27 October 2012.

- 3. Nothing in the Order will apply to:
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the execution of the said works; or
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police officer in uniform or a traffic warden.
- 4. These temporary restrictions are to be introduced by this notice given under Section 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. It is anticipated that the works will be completed within 2 days.
- 5. The prohibitions will apply only during such time and to such extent as indicated by prescribed traffic signs.
- 6. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction imposed by this notice or by the order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
