

**AFFORDABLE HOUSING**  
**SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)**

**ADOPTION STATEMENT**

On 6 March 2014 the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames adopted the Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). This Affordable Housing SPD is an update to the SPD adopted in 2003. The SPD sets out guidance on policy requirements to contribute towards affordable housing, to be addressed in all new housing development, changes of use for wholly residential and mixed use sites incorporating residential use, where planning permission is required.
