Applications to vote by proxy at this referendum applied for on grounds of physical incapacity or employment, where that physical incapacity / absence due to employment occurred after 5 p.m. on Wednesday 10 October 2018 must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at York House Stable Block, Richmond Road, Twickenham, TW1 3AA by 5 p.m. on Thursday 18 October 2018.
