



## NOTICE OF REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES

1. Notice is hereby given that Richmond upon Thames Council ('the Council') is conducting a review of the polling districts, polling places and polling stations that fall within the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames.
2. The (Acting) Returning Officer (ARO) for the Parliamentary Constituencies of Richmond Park and Twickenham will make comment on the proposals and those representations will be published on the Council's website in accordance with the timetable set out below.
3. Electors within the London Borough of Richmond upon Thames may make a representation.
4. The Council would welcome the views of all residents, particularly disabled residents, or any person or body with expertise in access for persons with any type of disability, on the proposals, and ARO's representation, or any other related matters.
5. Persons or bodies making representations should, if possible, give alternative places that may be used as polling places.
