# **How Do I Recycle More?**

#### OK

- Polystyrene
- Nappies, tissues and sanitary products
- "Crinkly" plastic films (e.a. crisp packets and sweet wrappers)
- Animal waste Broken crockery
- Other household waste that can't be recycled

#### **NO THANKS**

- Food waste (except flats\*)
- Garden waste
- Batteries • Electrical items
- Textiles
- Other recyclable items
- Construction and demolition waste
- Commercial waste
- Gas bottles/cannisters

\*Flats: use your communal food waste bins if provided

#### REMEMBER Houses and

- converted flats: Leave your baa/ bin just inside the front boundary of your property no later than 6am on collection day
- Flats: Use your communal wheeled bins as required
- Bin baas containina garden waste will not be collected. Please use the garden waste service.

#### TIPS

- Houses and converted flats: Buy and use dustbins or wheelie bins to stop litter and scavenging animals
