



Carlisle Park

Accessibility Guide

Description

The park is popular with families and dog walkers and is used for sports at the weekend.

Facilities in the park

The park is well planted with mature trees, shrubs, and flowerbeds. This large park has the following facilities:

- Bowling Green
- Cricket pitch
- Three junior football pitches
- Seven tennis courts
- Toilets
- Play area

Visiting the park

The park is locked at night. For seasonal opening times see www.richmond.gov.uk/parks_opening_times

Transport

The nearest train station is Hampton 0.71km (0.44miles).

The park is served by the following bus routes: R70 and R68

R70 - The nearest bus stop is Wensleydale Road which is 0.44km (0.28 miles) from the park entrance.

R68 - The nearest bus stop is Hampton Pool which is 0.74km (0.46 miles) from the park entrance.

There is cycle parking next to the children's playground.

Parking

There is a small car park within the park. It can be accessed from Wensleydale Road. There is a 5mph speed limit on the entrance road.



Disabled Parking

There is a designated Blue Badge parking space.

Park access

There is a vehicle entrance off Wensleydale Road.



Vehicle and pedestrian access from Wensleydale Road

There are 3 pedestrian access points to the park. One from Wensleydale Road, one from Carlisle Road and one from Wensleydale Gardens.

All entrances have level access at the entrance / exits points. All gates are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.

Entrance to facilities

There are two **children's playgrounds**. Both are fenced with a gate wide enough for wheelchair access.



Tennis courts

The tennis courts are fenced and accessed via gates along a tarmacked path between the tennis courts and pavilion building. The gates are wide enough to allow wheelchair access.

Paths

There are surfaced paths throughout the park.
All the paths are wide enough for wheelchair users.

There are no steps on the paths. There is a circular walk around the park on surfaced paths

Benches

There are bench seats at regular intervals along the paths for people to rest. There are quiet areas with some seating.

Toilets

There are toilet facilities available for public use situated in the pavilion building. Access to the toilets is from the front of the pavilion adjacent to the playground.



The toilets are located opposite the tennis courts and accessed via three shallow steps.

Baby changing facilities are not available.

The **accessible toilet** is on the other side of the pavilion building and accessible using a RADAR key.



The path to the accessible toilet is slightly uneven and narrowed by vegetation.

Refreshments

There are no refreshment facilities available in the park.

There are no facilities to provide a bowl of water for an assistance dog.

There is a drinking fountain located on the wall adjacent to the toilets.

Playgrounds

There is a selection of play equipment suitable for disabled visitors including an accessible roundabout.



There are two benches in each of the playground areas.

There are 2 picnic tables in the larger playground.
