### **Teddington Parking consultation results: Zone T3 and T6**

In July/August, we consulted all properties in this area on the introduction of two new controlled parking zones (T3 and T6) as part of the wider review of parking in Teddington – see attached drawing.

A summary of each consultation, along with the results and the decision on the way forward are as follows:

#### Zone T3 Consultation

This comprised consultation with all properties of roads approximately south of, but excluding, Somerset Road on proposals to implement a new CPZ (Zone T3) operating Monday to Friday 10am – Noon.

The results of this consultation showed:

- Out of 658 properties consulted, 75 responded to the consultation via the on-line questionnaire – a response rate of 11%
- Of the 75 who responded, 33 indicated their support for the CPZ with 24 indicating their opposition to it with 18 making general comments

The decision has been made to implement this CPZ after consideration of the results of this and previous consultations undertaken in the area. Stuart Grove will be added to this scheme given the support shown from this road for parking controls. A further letter will be sent out to all properties within the new zone in early 2023 which will provide details on the start date of the scheme and it will enclose application forms for parking permits.

#### Zone T6 Consultation

This comprised consultation with all properties approximately north of, and including, Somerset Road on whether they would wish to have a new CPZ (Zone T6) implemented operating Monday to Friday 10am – Noon.

The results of this consultation showed:

- Out of 1000 properties consulted, 219 responded to the consultation via the on-line questionnaire – a response rate of 22%
- Of the 219 who responded, 95 are in favour of the CPZ and 117 are against it with 7 expressing no view

The decision has been made not to implement this scheme having considered the results of this consultation. New double yellow lines will, however, be

implemented in the area, including in York Road and Railway Road. A new footway parking exemption in Railway Road will also be implemented. All these measures are being implemented on road safety grounds.

A further letter will be sent out to all properties in this area early in 2023 providing details on when the double yellow lines and footway parking exemption will be implemented.
