SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT (SPD)**

ADOPTION STATEMENT

In accordance with Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the Refuse and Recycling Storage Requirements Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) was formally adopted by the Council on 8 May 2015.

This SPD sets out the local requirements for the provision, design and location of refuse and recycling storage in residential, commercial and mixed-use developments; it supersedes previous guidance produced in 2004.
