Dear Joanne Capper,

Many thanks for the clarification, and for sharing the link to the initial feasibility study.

I have now read the documents and I have concerns regarding the proposed location of Bridge 15, mainly due to the increase in traffic this will cause. Orleans Road, which would provide the only car access to the bridge on the Twickenham side, is already heavily trafficked by cars carrying visitors to Marble Hill Park and Orleans House. The situation is similar on the Ham side, where a footbridge is likely to significantly increase car traffic to Ham Street Car Park.

I cannot see any reference to a traffic or parking assessment as part of the considerations in the bridge feasibility study. Surely it would be preferable to place such a the bridge in a location where it would encourage an increase in pedestrian and bicycle access, without increasing car traffic? The proposed location of Bridge 13 seems much more suitable from that perspective.

I would appreciate it if you could take my concerns into account when finalising the Local Plan.
