There is Duplo Lego available for very young attendees.

Skills/abilities/knowledge required	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Outgoing personality. • Be reliable and able to help on a regular basis. • An interest and enthusiasm in working with young people. • Self-sufficient and can work independently but feel confident to ask questions should the need arise. • To undergo the council's Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check.

Length of commitment	Minimum 12-month commitment.
