FOREWORD

Welcome to the Richmond Work Match Annual Report celebrating the 2025-26 achievements of local residents and businesses.

Richmond Work Match celebrated its 5th anniversary this year. More than 1,200 Richmond residents have moved into training and sustainable local jobs through the council's Work Match service. It helps meet local demand for skilled workers, strengthening the borough's economy, and supporting residents into good, long-term jobs that improve wellbeing and independence.

On its fifth anniversary, Richmond Work Match launched a new initiative, Connect to Work. This aims to help even more residents into employment, particularly those with long-term health conditions, disabilities, or facing other barriers to work.

In March 2026 Richmond Council launched the Richmond Growth Plan, which is our vision for inclusive, sustainable growth over the next decade. A key part of the growth plan is:

Delivering for our people

- Create opportunities for all and better jobs and incomes through rewarding careers in high-quality and healthy workplaces.
- Support residents through upskilling, training and learning to succeed in a high value local economy.
- Develop career paths to higher earnings, especially for lower income groups - reducing income inequality.
- More support for residents who find it difficult to stay in work due to health conditions or caring responsibilities.
- More tailored support for residents who face multiple barriers to work to access good quality jobs, leading to healthier, more independent lives.
- Greater investment in a wider range of housing options, including affordable housing, to meet acute local housing need and allow more residents to work locally.

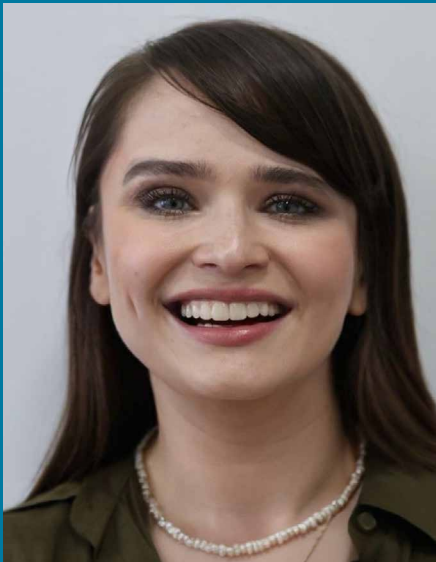

I used the Work Match service provided by the council on two occasions first straight after graduating from university, and again after a career break. On both occasions, the support I received was invaluable.

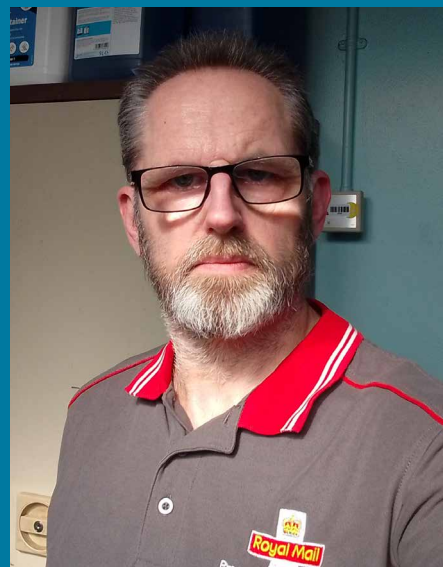

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RICHMOND HOUSING PARTNERSHIP

RHP Group's partnership with Work Match has played a crucial role in improving their recruitment process and widening access to opportunities for local residents. By combining RHP's commitment to community with Work Match's expertise in local employment support, the organisations have successfully identified strong, suitable candidates and created greater pathways into work. This case study outlines the impact of that collaboration.

How did you find the overall experience of working with Work Match?

I've found Richmond Work Match to be incredibly helpful and supportive. They'll ask questions to clarify and understand what we're looking for, and they are as passionate as we are at supporting local people. Their values very much align with ours.

What difference did our support make to your recruitment process?

It helped us to reach out and target local people, who were not confident in applying for vacancies by supporting the application.

What stood out to you about the candidates we put forward?

The problem we've had in the past is candidates not being suitable for the roles they applied for. All candidates put forward by Work Match were suitable for the roles. Those that were unsuccessful were only bettered by a more suitable and experienced candidate.

Would you recommend Work Match to other local employers, and if so, why?

If you're looking to support your community then Work Match is where you need to go. This is what I'd advise as Work Match have a far better insight to the local area than many employers.

How does our partnership help promote local opportunities to residents?

As a social housing provider, we have access to our customers/tenants, but there are a whole group of local people that would never get in touch with us, and this is where Work Match really help to promote our opportunities. We have discussed many projects we'd like to work on, and I look forward to taking these forward.
