Key areas included aligning the understanding of event-day operations and reviewing the potential for future improvements.
London Borough of Richmond Upon Thames	Planning Officer(s) Transport Officer	13 February 2025 in person meeting 10 April 2025 in person meeting	An initial meeting was held to discuss the proposals, the approach to the transport assessment, and the package of proposed transport interventions. Further analysis was requested on weekday events.  A second meeting was held to follow up on the points raised in the first meeting, during which weekday analysis was presented for previous non-sporting weekday events.
London Borough of Hounslow	Transport Officer(s)	8 April 2025 online meeting	Discussion on proposals, transport assessment scope and proposed transport interventions. Aspirations to influence travel behaviours within LBH were discussed, such as encouraging more visitors to use Hounslow East London Underground (LUL) services, alongside the existing Controlled Parking Zone (CPZ).
Transport for London (TfL) Pre-App	TfL Spatial Planning TfL Road Development Team Service Delivery Manager for TfL bus services	26 March 2025 in person meeting	Discussion covered the proposals, transport assessment scope, and proposed transport interventions. TfL agreed with the Transport Assessment scope in principle and requested a women's safety audit within the TA. Detailed traffic modelling was discussed, and it was agreed that this would not be appropriate in this scenario.

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South Western Railway / Network Rail	13 participants from SWR / Network Rail on the call	28 March 2025 online meeting	Discussion focused on proposals and proposed transport interventions, with particular emphasis on rail users. Existing event-day operations were reviewed, including crowd management measures and the number of services available before and after events. The roll out of newer 10-car trains was also discussed, noting that this is already underway.
London Borough of Richmond Upon Thames	Environmental Health Officer	22 January, meeting	The meeting discussed the supplementary noise report sent in advance to LBRuT. The council EHO requested further information related to the assessment of crowd noise and produced a 10 point summary which identified the points that were raised. It was agreed that these points would be reviewed and taken into account for the final supplementary noise report. This report will be appended to the ES.
London Borough of Richmond Upon Thames	Planning Officer Transport Officer	03 March 2026, in person and online hybrid meeting	Discussion focused on the transport work to date, covering the overall transport context, event-day strategy, available baseline information and the scope of the assessment work. The approach to using historic data was noted, along with several initial points raised by LBRuT regarding consideration of the wider network, interaction with TfL, SWR and NR, and the next steps of certain interventions.
